Dear friends. Proposal to form a non-profit association governed by the provisions of the Luxembourg Law of April 21, 1928 on non-profit associations and foundations,

- to associate with, or initiate, actions of Global Public Interest, of an educational and humanitarian nature, carried out by the districts and clubs.
- to pay particular attention to the younger generations by promoting meetings and cultural, leisure and professional exchanges.
- to provide support for the development of the major programs of Rotary International and its Foundation.
- and to initiate all other actions within the objectives and goals of Rotary International.

The association is part of the Rotarian ICC / CIP program and therefore complies with the statutes of Rotary International as well as the R.O.I. specific to the ICC/CIP program of the BELUX zone. Members are:
